The Grand Canyon Railway Will Offer Half Off Tickets on Valentine's Day

WILLIAMS, ARIZ. (January 20, 2015) – This Valentine's Day, grab the ones you love and hop aboard the <u>Grand Canyon Railway</u> (GCR). The Railway has announced it will offer a "Sweetheart Deal", with half off all rides on Saturday, February 14, 2015.

The train departs at 9:30 a.m. from historic Williams, Arizona – near the iconic Route 66. The trip, which takes two hours and fifteen minutes each way, traverses the Colorado Plateau, passing beautiful landscapes from pine forest to desert forest. This is the land of the Navajo, Hopi, Havasupai and Paiute Native Americans, as well as elk, mountain lions, bald eagles and California condors. The Train will arrive back in Williams from the South Rim at 5:45 p.m.
